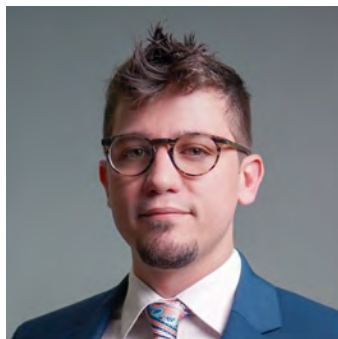
GARY KOST
