

VOLUNTEER TOOLKIT: Register to Vote Edition

Here are some quick and easy actions you can take from your home to help your friends, family, and community get registered to vote in this election!

1. FIRST UP -- HAVE YOU REGISTERED TO VOTE/MADE SURE YOUR REGISTRATION WAS UP TO DATE?

It'll be a lot easier to explain the process to your friends and family if you've done it yourself, first! To check if you're registered visit wt.ncsbe.gov/RegLkup/. If you're not registered, no worries! We've got a guide for that -- head over to www.ncdp.org/register-to-vote/.

2. NEXT, ENCOURAGE 5 OF YOUR FRIENDS TO REGISTER TO VOTE, TOO!

Help your family members submit their forms, text a friend the link to online voter registration, and send your coworkers the link with instructions! <u>Here's an example script</u>.

3. POST THIS PICTURE TO YOUR FACEBOOK, TWITTER, INSTAGRAM, ETC.!

Spreading the word about voting by mail is going to be so important! If your friends and family see that you're registered to vote, they will be more likely to do it, too! **Don't underestimate the power of your voice.**
